## **INTRODUCTION ABOUT COLLEGE**

This college was established in July, 1973 by Sh. Kesho Dass from Pathankot and initially named after its founder as 'Thakur Kesho Dass College'. The state Government took over this college on August 15, 1984 and rechristened as Govt. College Dhaliara. Located in the serene and sylvan environment about 400 mtr away from the Dhaliara market on Dharmshala Chandigarh road, this college is an ideal place for learning and fulfilled the long cherished dream of the people in the catchment area of approx. 25km. Despite its humble beginning the institution kept a pragmatic approach and at present emerged as one of the big colleges not only in the Distt. Kangra but of the whole state. At present 1927 students are on roll in BA, B.Sc, and B.Com streams along with MA English, MA Hindi, MA Economics, M.Com., M.Sc. Physics and M.Sc. Chemistry. Besides, the college has BBA, BCA, MBA and PGDCA under the Self Financing Schemes and a study centre of IGNOU. The college can boast of vast infrastructure, well equipped laboratories, a big multipurpose hall, very well stocked library, career guidance cell, two units of NSS/Bharat Scouts & Guides each, two well equipped computer labs and a playground for sports activities. The college had progressed rapidly during the past one year with many first and pioneering initiatives in academics, sports, and extra-curricular activities. This year the top floor of old Chemistry Block was constructed making it a state of art infrastructure with a built up area of 6000sq.feet which will facilitates the Self Finance students with well equipped laboratories, a new Library and six class rooms. To cater to the growing needs of the students and people of the area this year Bachelor Programme in Vocational Education (B.Voc. Retail Management and Tourism & Hospitality) was started with the purpose to provide new opportunities and new knowledge to the students. Efforts are also made to start an integrated four year B.Ed., MA in History, MA Pol. Science. Besides, the demarcation of the college land, a barbed wire fencing, landscaping and many other developmental works were done during this year. The college is on track towards constructing a playground, a Swimming Pool, a Shooting Coaching Center which will be developed further as a sports complex. In the NAAC ranking framework the college is accredited as a much improved 'B' Grade institution in 2019 and, thus takes pride in thanking the predecessors for providing the building blocks on which this present edifice of the college stands. With undaunted determination and perseverance of its incumbents, this college has flourished over the years and reaches its pinnacle where it can boast of quality education.

Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) (National Higher Education Mission) is a holistic scheme of development for higher education in India initiated by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India which aims at providing strategic funding to the eligible state higher educational institutions. Our college follows the H.P.U. concept of CBCS (Choice Based Credit System). The CBCS is an instructional package developed to suit the needs of the students to keep pace with the developments in the higher education worldwide. Further under the scheme of strategic funding the following works, viz., Conference Hall (amounting to Rs. 1314177) and Toilet Block for Boys and Girls (amounting to Rs. 2044500/-) is already completed. Further, the Play Ground (amounting to Rs. 3780300/-) was deposited to HPPWD and the work is under progress. Various renovations and purchase of equipments for different departments were executed and purchased respectively under RUSA “Infrastructure Grants to the Colleges” Solar panel were also installed in the College.

### **Library**

Our college has a very well stocked library having approx. 20000 books. The post of librarian is vacant the charge of library is with **Dr. Suresh Kumar** (Assistant Prof. in Sanskrit). During this session new books amounting approximately to Rs. One Lakh were acquired. An amount of more than 10 thousand rupees was spent on the purchase of various newspapers. 1. 4. Since the more subjects have already been added to offer graduation and post graduation courses in Arts and Commerce and Science the requirements for augmentation in infrastructure and additional accommodation are sorely felt.
5. Construction of auditorium and canteen is urgently needed.


